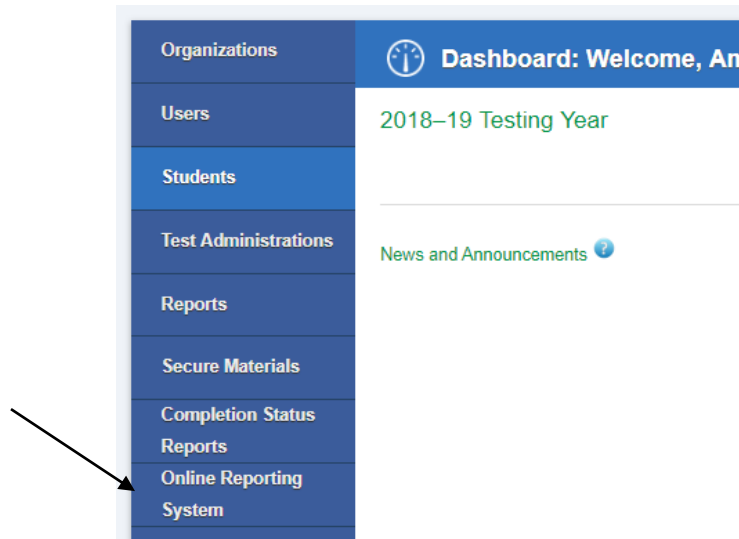

Click on the TOMS

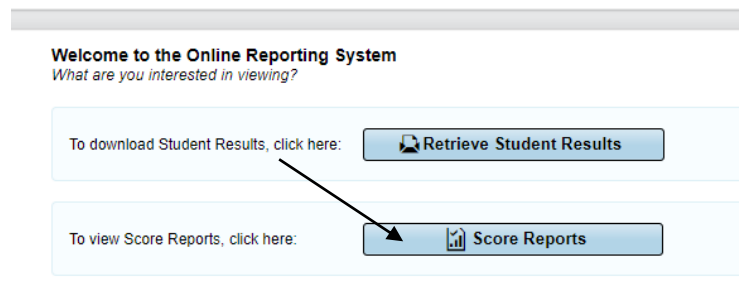
